

District of Columbia's Medicaid Promoting Interoperability FAQ: PROVIDER INFORMATION PRE-ELIGIBILITY

Overview

To ensure eligibility to participate in the Promoting Interoperability (PI) Program, Eligible Providers (EP) must confirm their provider information is up to date in the District of Columbia's Medicaid Provider Data Management System (PDMS). To review or update individual provider information in the DC PDMS, please log into the web portal at www.DCPDMS.com.

Q: What Provider Information is Needed to Meet the Pre-Eligibility Requirements?

The following provider information below must be reviewed for accuracy and completeness *prior* to attesting to the PI program.

- Social Security Number** – confirm and/or update the provider's social security number
- Medical License Status** - confirm the license number, state, expiration date, and licensing board is current for program year 2019
- DC Medicaid Enrollment Status** - confirm the enrollment end date is current for program year 2019
- Organization Affiliation** – confirm and/or update the Group Name, Medicaid ID, NPI, and Tax ID of the organization the provider intends to disburse the incentive amount to

** Please note ONLY new and re-enrolling providers must complete [the Electronic Funds Transfer \(EFT\) Form](#) and upload it to the PDMS to receive payment directly into their bank account. Providers that are currently enrolled in EFT are not required to submit another form.
