PROGRAM INTRODUCTION

The DC Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF) has engaged eHealthDC to deliver customized and tailored technical assistance (TA) to support the advancement of digital health capabilities for Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) providers. Our team will offer TA to promote the adoption and use of Certified Health IT systems, health information exchange (HIE), and telehealth.

3 TA TRACKS FOR EHR AND DC HIE CONNECTIVITY



Track 1: Implement New EHR

Provider does not currently use an EHR or needs to migrate to a new Certified EHR to connect to DC HIE



Track 2: Upgrade Existing EHR

Provider has an existing EHR but is not using the latest or certified version of the EHR to connect to DC HIE



Track 3: Optimize Existing EHR or Case Management System

Provider using Certified EHR or case management system but is not yet fully connected to DC HIE



End Destination

- Adopt a Certified EHR
- Connect to DC HIE (CRISP)
- Send EHR patient encounter data to DC HIE
- Send EHR Clinical documents to DC HIE

TELEHEALTH SERVICES

Stage 1

- Assess provider readiness to deploy telehealth
- Address needs of provider organizations and consumers



Stage 2

- Adopt mobile devices and laptops for telehealth use
- Implement new/ modify existing telehealth workflows



Stage 3

- Monitor telehealth usage
- Maximize telehealth utilization, increase access to care, and improve health outcomes

- ✓ Identify team members to participate in workflow and system design
- ✓ Understand technology barriers, challenges, and opportunities for end users



PROGRAM INCENTIVES

HCBS practices (inclusive of behavioral health, long term support services, disabilities services, and housing support services) can earn incentives available from DHCF that contribute to the selection, adoption, and implementation of health IT and/or approved case management systems and connection to the DC HIE.

Incentive amounts available to HCBS practices vary by track. eHealthDC TA will assist each participating practice in developing a plan to achieve applicable milestones and submit attestations through the District's State Level Registry to receive incentive payments.
