Technical Support & Assistance Pathways



EHR Data Quality and Workflow Optimization

- **Standardize Data Capture:** Optimize structured EHR data entry for consistent documentation
- **Optimize Workflows:** Use workflow mapping to identify and bridge critical gaps
- **Strengthen Quality Reporting:** Support clinical documentation improvement and performance metrics for accurate reporting



Health Information Exchange Adoption

- **Expand HIE Awareness & Use:** Provide CRISP DC onboarding support and tool training
- **Enhance Care Coordination:** Integrate HIE data into clinical workflows to improve decision-making
- **Improve Population Health:** Use HIE tools to drive readiness for value-based care
